**Implementation of the Revised National Park Entrance Fees and Conservation fee**

The Ministry has obtained all necessary approvals to implement the revised National Parks entrance fees and the introduction of the conservation fees with effect from 01 April 2021.

The new rates are as follows:

- Fees are valid for 24 hours period beginning at the time of entry, per person, per park.
- Park fees are payable for every day, for visitors and vehicles.
- Minimum amount payable is for 24 hours (1 day), and thereafter in units of 24 hours (1 day).
- Fees are non-refundable, and not transferable.

Given that Namibia's park entrance fees are currently one of the lowest in the SADC Region and given the shortfall in resources needed to conserve wildlife and maintain infrastructure in national parks, the Ministry is introducing payment of a conservation fee charged to all visitors to national parks and game parks in addition to the existing park entrance fees.

Namibia has not adjusted or increased the park entrance fees since 2005. The combined fee of conservation fee and park entrance fee is affordable and based on a market related price. The Ministry has consulted with stakeholders in the tourism industry in developing the new fees structure.

The conservation fee will accrue to the Game Product Trust Fund, and used for the management and maintenance of infrastructure in national parks and game parks; human wildlife conflict mitigation and preventative measures; and wildlife protection and law enforcement.
